LETTER OF AGREEMENT #2 BETWEEN GRAND LEDGE PUBLIC SCHOOLS AND

EATON COUNTY EDUCATION ASSOCIATION/ GRAND LEDGE EDUCATION ASSOCIATION, MEA/NEA

Re: Hiring Shortage - Teaching on Planning

- 1. This Letter of Agreement is developed, approved and executed between the Grand Ledge Public Schools Board of Education (the "District") and the Eaton County Education Association/Grand Ledge Education Association, MEA/NEA (the "Association").
- 2. The conditions and modifications established through this Letter of Agreement shall be effective for the duration of the 2021 2022 school year only.
- 3. Teaching on planning shall be voluntary. Teachers can volunteer to teach on their planning time, administrators have the overall right of assignment. Administrators may ask if a teacher is willing to teach on their planning time, but the teacher has the overall right to deny an additional class.
- 4. The stipend for a teacher assigned to teach on their planning period for the 2021-2022 school year shall be \$3000/trimester. The stipends will be paid no later than the 2nd pay after the end of the trimester.
- 5. This letter of agreement shall become effective upon the execution by the District and the Association. It is expressly understood and agreed that this Letter of Agreement does not establish a binding working condition, or obligation of either party after June 30, 2022 at its term shall expire on that date.
