Compensation Rate

The compensation rate of the Board Members has to be approved every year for attendance at regularly scheduled meetings and official board functions.

It is recommended to maintain the \$1,500 cap per year, per member with a meeting rate of \$40. *This is the rate established in 2013 with no increase.*

The Revised School Code (MCL 380.1) et seq), which became effective on July 1, 1996, provided the opportunity for local school districts to change their operational status.

Designation of Persons Authorized to Sign Checks, Contracts, Agreements and Purchase Orders

It is recommended the Board of Education follow the customary practice and designate the Superintendent and Chief Financial Officer of Grand Ledge Public Schools as those authorized to sign checks, contracts, agreements and purchase orders.



Designation of Official Publication / Person for Posting Notices

The Revised School Code recommends that all legal transactions of the Board be published in a local newspaper.

It is recommended we continue using the Lansing State Journal as the official newspaper for publication purposes and that the Superintendent (or his designee) be the person designated for posting the Board of Education's transactions.



Delegation of Electronic Transfer Officer (ETO)

It is recommended this delegation be given to the Chief Financial Officer of Grand Ledge Public Schools.



Setting of Fee Charged to Individuals who Request Notice of Board Meetings

It is recommended the Board establish the fee charged to individuals who request notice of Board Meetings at the rate of postage established by the United State Postal Service at the time of mailing. Individuals may provide the Superintendent's Office with self-addressed, stamped envelopes and not incur a fee.



Delegation of Election Duties

The board has always delegated school district election duties to the Superintendent, or his designee. It is recommended this delegation continue.



Signatures on Labor Contracts

It is recommended the process of having all seven (7) members of the Board of Education sign all ratified labor agreements continue as has been the district's practice for several years.
