COMMUNITY

The Grand Ledge Public School District is in the norther most part of Eaton County, approximately 10 miles west of Lansing, MI. The city of Grand Ledge is located on the banks of the Grand River with a population of 7,900 residents. The district is mainly composed of students from middle class families, blending professional and skilled employed by the State of Michigan, Michigan State University, and Insurance Mecca. Majority of parents have college backgrounds. 27.2% of students qualify for free and reduced lunch.

GRADE POINT AVERAGE

Grade Point Averages are computed on a 4-point scale (A=4.0). All grades are included in the computing except G and PG (for credit/pass) grades. Classes are weighted equally, and all students are ranked in their class. Advanced Placement courses have a weighted grade point (A=5.0, B=4.0, C=3.0, and etc)

DUAL ENROLLMENT

- Majority of our students attend Lansing Community College, Michigan State University, and Kendall College of Arts and Design
- We also have students who are enrolled in CRT Early Middle College that is partnered with Lansing Community College and Davenport University
- 3% of students participate either in Dual Enrollment or Early Middle College

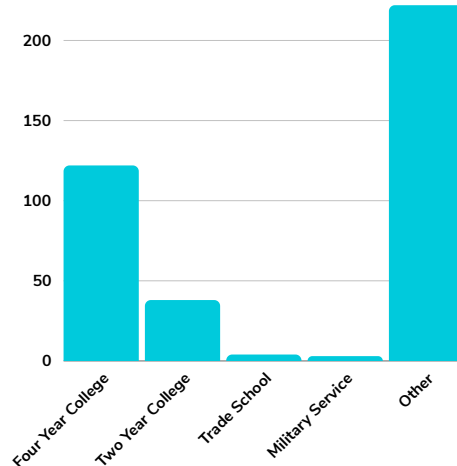

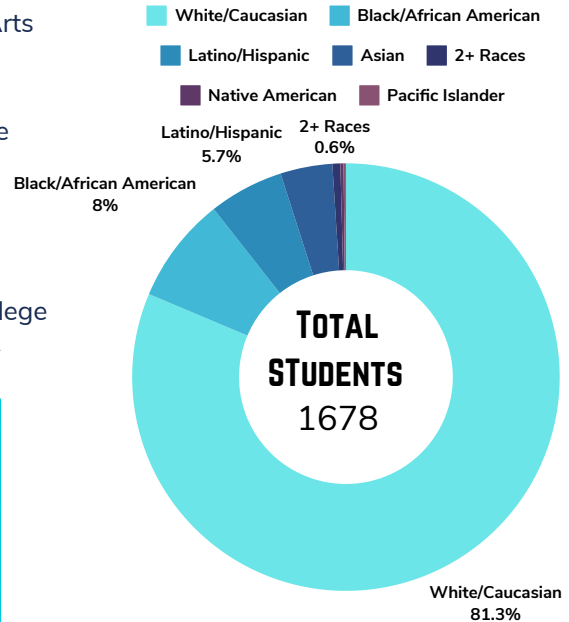
